| Giant Swallowtail | Citrus |
| Pipevine & Polydamas Swallowtail | Dutchman's Pipevine |
| Gulf Fritillary | Passionvine planted in sun |
| Zebra Longwing | Passionvine planted in shade |
| Orange-barred & Cloudless Sulphur | Cassias |
| Cassius Blue | Plumbago |

| Coral Honeysuckle | Gaillardia |
| Butterfly Bush | Mexican Heather |
| Firecracker Plant | Mexican Petunia |
| Plumbago | Sapphire Showers |

A Basic Outline for Designing Your Garden

- Choose a sunny location
- Include nectar plants to attract the butterflies
- Include host plants for the butterflies to lay their eggs
- Use large splashes of color like red and yellow
- Do not use pesticides in or near your butterfly garden
- Enjoy watching the butterflies!
